Age categories are based on the year of birth. For example, if someone is 17 years old on the day of the competition but will be 18 before the end of the year (2021) then he/she shall participate in the category of U30 (18 - 30 years old).

The organisers will allow DAN competitors moving up in 2022 to compete in both their old division and new division (for Dan individual categories only) – you will need to register the player twice as two separate competitors e.g. Jane Smith 1 and Jane Smith 2– amend the date of birth of the second one so it appears in the 2022 category – pairs & teams for players moving up can only enter one (your choice of 2021 or 2022 category). Players can only enter a maximum of one pair and one team.

Participants must enter as part of a club registration. Clubs must enter as individual clubs.

MIXED PAIRS APPLICATIONS - If you wish to enter mixed pairs competition, please note that there will be two separate event registrations on TPSS: One for Saturday and the DAN competition / One for Sunday and the KUP, Para, and Freestyle competition. Please ensure you enter in the correct category – on the correct day!



If you are registering pairs and teams from different clubs – please add the details in the comments box (partners/team members name, number and club etc).

NOTE Mixed club teams must have entered their own competitor as usual and the partner from another team (full name and club) in the remark (combining pairs/teams) box during registration on TPSS.

Please check all entries – amendments after the closing date will incur a £20 administration cost. No amendments will be made on the day.

METHOD OF COMPETITION

Cut-off System is to be used.

1st Round: 20 or more competitors.

2nd Round: 9-19 competitors or 50% from 1st Round.

Final: Top 8 Competitors:

(Groups with 9 competitors may be a straight final).

Organisers have the right to make any necessary changes.

COMPULSORY POOMSAE

The compulsory poomsae will be emailed out on Wednesday 24th November.

Competitors may be asked to perform any of the Poomsae from their set list in the order listed in the Compulsory Poomsae.

Two Poomsae will be performed in each round.



CLUB AWARDS:

1st place = 9 points

2nd place = 6 points

3rd place = 3 points

4th place = 2 points

Team Awards will be given out at the end

of each day.

10 EQUIPMENT

UNIFORMS (DOBOKS)

Participants are representing their club and are not allowed to wear GB or Home Counties printed doboks.

Plain doboks or club doboks only.

Normal doboks can also worn.

11 APPEALS

Any protests must be made by the Club Coach on completion of the Official Protest form within 10 minutes of the end of that contest to the Judging Director.

The protest fee is £75 (refunded if protest is won).



LIABILITY

All competitors participate at their own risk.

No claim whatsoever can be made against the organiser or British Taekwondo.

The organisers (British Taekwondo) shall not accept responsibility fo any damages, injuries, or losses sustained or incurred.

All freestyle competitors will need to sign a waiver on the day of the championships to accept full responsibility for any injury they may sustain.
