**Liability:** All competitors participate at their own risk. The online registration implies that the competitors agree to assume all responsibility for themselves and to release all other parties from any and all liability which may directly or indirectly result.

**Registration Conditions:** National membership identification card or a passport is a compulsory document for registration. Competitors must present evidence of a medical check-up no older than six months.

**Protest:** Only head of team have all rights to protest immediately after match. Protest fee of 50 € – is to be paid for every protest.

- The official WT Competition Rules will be used. The tournament will be based on a Single Elimination.
- All players competing will be provided with **DAEDO** electronic body protectors and E-Head Gear for their matches.
- All children (A and B class) using Head Gear with mask.
- All competitors must bring their own sensor socks.
- All age groups have A-class (standard rules - with kicks to the head), and B-class (kicks to the head are NOT allowed).
- All competitors must have registered medical exam not older than six months in order to participate.

**A class:** competitors with a minimum rank of 4th geup.

**B class:** competitors with a rank from 9th to 5th geup.

# POOMSAE

## Equipment:

- The contestants compete in taekwondo dobok, which MAY or MAY NOT be official. It is allowed to wear the standard taekwondo dobok.
- GAL/GOL license is not required for participation.

Scores will be given by 3 referees, with exclusion of highest and lowest marks in both accuracy and presentation marks.

## COMPETITION RULES

**Cut-off system semi-final:** When 9 and more contestants are participating; Competition shall start from semi-final round. Contestants shall perform the two assigned Compulsory Poomsae and 8 of them shall advance to the final on the basis of their points.

**Cut-off system finale:** When 8 or fewer contestants are participating; Competition shall start from the final round. Contestants shall perform two Poomsae, in accordance with the drawing of lots.

**NOTE:** If there are a large number of contestants, the organizer can change the way of qualifications - in each round contestants shall perform specified Poomsae in agreement with the Technical Commission for the A class. B class is done by one Poomsae chosen in each round of the competition. If a contestant repeats the performance Poomsae, final mark is reduced to 0.6. If a contestant performed a Poomsae that is not designated by draw sheet, final mark will be reduced by 1.0.

### DECISIONS AND DECLARED THE WINNER:

- The winner is the contestant who has the most points.
- In case there is a tied score after the completion of the final round on the rank 1, 2, or 3, the contestant who is awarded more points in presentation shall be declared the winner.
- In case the score is still tied, then the one who has higher total points (including highest and lowest points) shall be the winner.
- If it's still tied then a rematch between the contestants in question shall be conducted. The referee will decide on the Poomsae to be performed (in any case one of the compulsory Poomsae).

**NOTE:** Each individual performance is rated for team placement. Team placement will be evaluated especially in the A class and B class, as well as together in both categories

**FREE STYLE POOMSAE:** is the performance based on taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.

### Composition of Free Style Poomsae:

- Yeon-mu line shall be the choice of the contestant.
- Music & choreography shall be the choice of the contestant.

Performed techniques must be within boundary of taekwondo. The definition of taekwondo techniques shall be determined by Poomsae Committee, when contestant submits performance plan of free style Poomsae.
