Dear friends,

This year, we continue our Grand Prix cycle with the second stop of the ETU Grand Prix Open series. Following the successful launch of the cycle in Tirana, Albania, this second event will play a crucial role as part of the qualification pathway for the ETU Final Grand Prix in Sarajevo, Bosnia & Herzegovina on 5–7 December 2026.

As with the first event, ETU Grand Prix Open Ramus in Sofia, Bulgaria, will be graded as E6 and will award valuable points for the European Ranking. In addition, it will serve as a direct qualification opportunity for athletes aiming to secure their place at the ETU Final Grand Prix later this year.

The Grand Prix cycle is designed to create a structured pathway for emerging and elite athletes, supporting their development and preparing them for the demands of high-level international competition. This second event represents another important step in that journey.

We look forward to welcoming athletes, coaches and teams as we continue building momentum toward the ETU Final Grand Prix and shaping the future of European Taekwondo together.

13. METHOD OF COMPETITION AND CONTEST TIME

- Single elimination tournament system.
- Best of three (3) system will be used.
- 3(2) rounds of 1.5 minutes, one (1) minute break between each round.
- The Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he sees fit.

14. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING / MEDICAL MEETING

No meetings will be held. Information can be found in the applicable Telegram groups and on social media platforms.

15. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The following eligibility requirements are applicable:

1. Holder of a valid 2026 WT Global Athlete License.
2. Member of a pertinent Member National Association, recognized by European Taekwondo Union or World Taekwondo.
3. An athlete in order to be eligible for participation must be born in
 - a. Cadet athletes: 2012, 2013, 2014
 - b. Junior athletes: 2009, 2010, 2011
4. Cadet: Holder of 4th Kup or higher
5. Junior: Holder of 1st Kup or higher
6. All competitors must prove their age/nationality by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh in. For those athletes that are not adults, a written letter of consent must be submitted (please find enclosed on the last pages) at the registration, signed by one of the parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

17. QUOTA SPECIFIC RULES

The following rules are applicable for direct qualification for the ETU Final Grand Prix in Sarajevo, Bosnia & Herzegovina on 5 – 7 December 2026.

1. Top 4 athletes (Medalists) qualify directly for the E10 ETU Final Grand Prix in Sarajevo, Bosnia & Herzegovina on 5 – 7 December 2026.
2. The quota is strictly personal. Transfer of quota in another weight division is accepted.

18. COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Minimum age of 18 years
2. Holder of the WT Coach License Level I Coach Certification
3. Holder of a valid 2026 WT Global Official License
4. Coach is not allowed wearing Dobok
5. One (1) coach per five (5) athletes is allowed. Exceeding this ratio is subject to an extra fee.

19. MEDICAL STAFF ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Minimum age of 18 years
2. Holder of a valid 2026 WT Global Official License

19. SPORT ENTRIES

Team entries will only be accepted through the WT GMS online registration system Simply Compete. Registration of the athletes is only possible with a valid 2026 WT Global License (GL issued by assigned GMS club, Edition and Administrators only).

24. PROOF OF PAYMENT

All teams are required to send proof of payment (copy of bank transfer) to office@ramustkd.org within one (1) week after registration in Simply Compete or submit it at the registration appointment booking platform. The Organizing Committee has the right to delete sport entries from teams that do not send proof of payment from the system in order for other athletes to register and to prevent 'ghost athletes'.

Any athlete registering on-line who does not take part in the competition and who has not been removed from the entry list before the deadline 20 May 2026, is fully liable for paying his/her entry fee in full. For any athlete not presenting at registration, his/her team or official shall be liable for ensuring full payment of the entry fee of the aforementioned athlete prior to the team's participation. If a team does not show up at the event and has not requested a participation cancellation before the deadline, the Organizing Committee shall invoice the team for the full amount (100%) as per current outline.

25. NO REFUND POLICY

The Organizing Committee shall not refund entry fees paid.

27. FIELD OF PLAY REGULATIONS

By accepting the accreditation card, all accredited persons agree to comply with the Field of Play regulations applicable at European Taekwondo Union events.

1st place – gold medal & certificate

2nd place – silver medal & certificate

3rd place – medal & certificate

3rd place – bronze medal & certificate

All medal winners qualify to the ETU Final Grand Prix 5-7 December 2026 Sarajevo, Bosnia Herzegovina.

29. MEDICAL & ANTI-DOPING

The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.

1. Compulsory anti-doping tests may be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests may be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to the championships.
2. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption): Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up. Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form [HERE](#) and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport with copy to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by at least 30 days before the first competition day

32. INDEMNITIES

It is the responsibility of each registering team to ensure that their athletes and team officials have filled out the indemnification forms correctly and have duly signed them, there by indemnifying WT, ETU, the Organizing Committee and all other officials and athletes from any claims of injuries, losses or otherwise arising during participation at the **ETU Grand Prix Open Ramus 2026 E6** event for the or any activities linked therewith. It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure and guarantee that sufficient insurance coverage has been arranged for all athletes, team officials and other participants. Without sufficient insurance coverage, teams will not be allowed to compete. Please fill out the Personal Indemnity Forms and return them to the Organizing Committee before 20 May 2026. Each participant (athletes, team officials, etc.) must fill out the indemnification form

33. MEDICAL INSURANCE

All participating athletes, coaches, team officials, technical officials and participants at ETU events shall have mandatorily an international medical insurance that covers medical care (COVID included) and in case of emergency, repatriation to the country of origin, valid on the days present in the host country of the event. ETU nor the Organizing Committee shall be responsible to cover any medical costs incurred for medical treatment before, on or during the competition or repatriation in the broadest sense of the word. All relevant documents proving that such an insurance is present, including insurance policy papers, should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs. Each MNA, Team doctor or team medical staff must ensure their athletes and team officials have valid international health insurance that covers medical and emergency care at the designated hospitals in **Bulgaria** before arrival to the venue.

General

The OC cannot predict the developments in the next coming months with regard to the Corona COVID-16 outbreak in Europe. The teams have to bear in mind that due to the uncertain nature of the Corona COVID-16 outbreak and sole authority of each government on how to respond, restrictions to access the Host country may be applicable. It is the responsibility of each and every participating team to make sure they meet all entry requirements in order to enter the Host country and to monitor the **Bulgarian** policy with regard to entry policies.



Sufficient insurance

The teams are strongly urged and advised to make sure to have their own sufficient travel, cancellation and medical insurance.

Liability

In this respect, please be informed that the OC shall not and cannot be held liable for any expenses and costs incurred by the teams for travelling to the event in case of cancellation of the event due to (further) outbreak of the Corona COVID-16 virus in the Host Country. The teams are strongly urged and advised to make sure to have their own sufficient travel, cancellation and medical insurance. The OC shall not accept any claims or requests for compensation in case of cancellation of the event
